#### When Ness ran Diebold



After Eliot Ness's long career in law enforcement and public safety ran its course, he became chairman of the board of directors at Diebold, one of the country's leading producers of safes, locks and other security equipment. Starting in 1944,

Ness reorganized the company's management, completed a major merger and helped Diebold diversify into plastics and microfilming equipment. His reputation as a savvy businessman grew. Articles about him appeared in both Fortune and Newsweek.
