Clearing the Air



Long before environmental laws were enacted, Eliot Ness was serious about protecting public health — and that included clean air.

As Public Safety Director in Cleveland, he chartered an airplane and flew inspection missions to investigate violations of the city's "anti-smoke ordinance." Violators were issued warnings and, in rare cases, were fined for noncompliance.
