**Friday, July 17**

**“The Siege of Coudersport.”**

--Al Capone's outfit rolls into town and takes command.

--Other gangsters follow suit.

--As tensions rise, the rival crime bosses confer for a peace deal.

--Order seems to be restored, but the sinister forces have the run of the town. They've bought off the local constabulary and public officials.



**Saturday, July 18**

**“The Untouchables Arrive in Town.”**

--Ness summons finalists and interviews them to fill his team of special agents at the Coudersport Theatre (a theatrical performance open to the public).

--Also at the theater, descendants of the REAL Untouchable agents who served under Eliot Ness discuss their ancestors' service (literally making history in little Coudersport, Pa.!).

--Ness and his chosen agents go by convoy to the Courthouse Square to announce that the siege of Coudersport will come to an end.

--Festival attendees can follow the Untouchables as they perform a series of raids and restore order, arresting and jailing Al Capone in the process.



**Sunday, July 19**

**“Touched by the Untouchable”**

--Capone goes on trial for his criminal activities. Testimony will be loosely based on the actual 1931 trial that resulted in Capone being sent to prison, blending some whimsical moments with actual witness recollections.

--*(Due to anticipated high demand for tickets, two performances are planned, 1 pm and again at 2 pm).*
